**Indoor Arena at Cheston Farm E.C.**

**20x40 OUTDOOR WARM UP UNDER FLOODLIGHTS from 5PM.**

Spectators: Attend at their own risk! Parking is limited. You must park on yard or across road.

Viewing from seated areas or café only. No spectators in horse areas/arenas!

CLASSES/APPROX TIMES: Enter just A (Clear Round) or just B (Competition) or both options. £5per class

A. **Clear round** – Height as per class. Lead rein, instruction & support. Ideal for lead rein children and the truly terrified! Rosettes 'Clear Round'. No elimination rule. Fillers in or out.

B. **Competition:**. Rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> -3<sup>rd</sup> and Specials. 2-phase jump off judged on speed or style. Joker Optional.

**5.00pm:** 1A/B. (1ft) Lead rein/helpers. Fee £5 incl Hot Drink. Class included in CFEC Mini PC.

**6-ish** 2.A/B (1'6-1'9) Class 2B Jump Off judged on 5 stages of jumping, style and equitation.

**7-ish** 3A/B. (2-2'3) Joker fences at 2'6. Class 3B includes Speed Jump Off.

**7.30-ish** 4A/B. (2'3- 2'6) Joker fence at 2'9. Class 4B includes Speed Jump Off.

**8-ish** 5A/B. (2'6-2'9) Class if sufficient entries. Joker at 3ft. 5B includes Speed Jump Off

**9-10pm Approx pre-booked schooling rounds.** 3foot max, £10pp for 30min. No outdoor warm up. No instruction. Phone to pre-book 01364 388188 strictly in advance please

# SHOW JUMPING NIGHTS AT CHESTON.

General terms and conditions –

CFEC Competitions 2017

**Unaffiliated competition:** A relaxed and fun event for the enjoyment of jumping. No special dress code, but no jumping without appropriate tack, footwear and head gear. You and your horse must be safe and have basic competence to take part in this event or you will be asked to depart. Fun and informal: Riders should come to enjoy the spirit in which this event is held.

**Please be aware we currently have no timing equipment. Speed classes are timed using a stopwatch.**

**Horse and Rider behaviour:** Misuse of whip, spurs or fists, rude language and dangerous riding is not appropriate and you will be asked to leave by the Centre. Any reports or acts of poor riding or dangerous horses will be taken seriously.

1. All competitors and their associates take full responsibility for their own health and safety on site and the actions and behaviour of themselves and their horse(s). The Organisers do not accept responsibility for any damages or accidents involving competitors or any of the competitor's associates, vehicles or horses.
2. The Organisers of these events have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the Organisers / instructors. Spectators are not to approach horses or stand in horse areas unless they wish to accept the ever present danger that horses pose! Enter at your own risk!
3. Participants, or their parents/guardians if rider is under 18 years, must consider themselves competent to complete the activity for which they are entering. It is not the responsibility of the Organisers to decide if a competitor is competent or their mount is suitable for the class. If the Organiser deems any rider or horse to be unsuitable / unsafe to participate they will be asked to leave immediately and no refund will be given.
4. The Organisers, their representatives or helpers do not accept liability for injury, damage or loss suffered by spectators, competitors, their horses, grooms, friends, vehicles or property however caused and under any circumstances.
5. No unauthorised instructors or persons in the warm up and/or indoor arena. Exception: Lead rein riders!
6. Outside assistance. Only permitted in Clear Round by CFEC staff and not in competition classes.
7. A correctly fitting riding hat complying with current safety standards, and safe footwear must be worn whilst mounted. Body protectors are strongly recommended for show jumping.
8. Horses must be 4 years old or over to be eligible to compete. Animals deemed to be sick or lame will not be allowed to compete or be ridden on site and a refund will not be given. Stallions are not eligible for these competitions unless by prior agreement.
9. We reserve the right to cancel or alter any part or the whole of the schedule at any time. Please contact us in case of poor weather to confirm the evening is going ahead.
10. The judge's decision is final. No quibbling!
11. It is the responsibility of all participants to clear up their horse dropping before leaving the site.
12. All dogs on a lead at all times.
13. The Organisers reserve the right to require anyone to leave the site without the need to give a reason.

**WEATHER: PLEASE CHECK IN EVENT OF POOR WEATHER!**

Please remember to check if the **weather** is extremely poor! We may go ahead in heavy rain using the Indoor Arena and the first fence as a warm up if extremely wet. In the event of high winds, freezing temperatures you must check to ensure the competition is still running.
